

Machine Applique Circle Block: (make one with each of the following 5 1/2" square colors: yellow, orange, red, fuchsia, amethyst, pink, turquoise, cobalt, lime green and green)

Use the circle template below to trace and cut ten 5 1/2" white fabric square and also the light fusible interfacing.




Place one white fabric circle with a light fusible interfacing (make sure the sticky side of the interfacing is facing down, touching the white fabric), pin in place and stitch 1/4" all the way around the circle. Clip the excess to the fabric around the circle. Make a 1" cut only at the interfacing and turn the circle inside out. Fold one 5 1/2" yellow fabric square in fourth and press with your fingers to mark the center, do the same with the white circle. Lay the white fabric circle matching the centers with the yellow fabric square, press in place with the iron. Machine applique stitching around the circle. Repeat with all the 10 different colors.





Dark Grey/White Curved Block:

Use the same curved templates from September, pages 15 and 16. Use the Template A to trace and cut 4 dark grey $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Use the Template B to trace and cut 4 white $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Piece the templates together, make 4 units.



Red and White Star Block:

Using the "Flipping Method" (see page 6 for more details), align one 3 1/2" red square with a 6" x 3 1/2" white piece. Mark a diagonal line on the red square from corner to corner. Sew on the marked line. Trim the sew allowances to 1/4" as shown. Flip the result triangle and press. Repeat the process on the other side. Trim the unit to 5 1/2" x 3". **Make 4 units**.












Assembly:
